UNIT 1: BROWN GIRL DREAMING MEMOIR

- ☐ Review the Unit-Specific Notes:
 - This unit does not use a student reader file. Instead you will need to obtain the memoir <u>Brown Girl Dreaming</u>, by Jacqueline Woodson, Penguin Young Readers Group, ISBN 9780147515827 and you will need to have this book on hand for the entire 4-5 weeks of this unit. Your local library likely owns a copy of this very popular book.
 - Reminder: Print the Activity Book for each unit before starting the unit.
 - If working with your own copy of the book for this unit, it is strongly
 recommended that you number the lines of the poems used in the lessons prior
 to starting a lesson. This will make it much easier to follow the instructions in the
 Teacher's Guide.
 - The optional Fluency Supplement mentioned in a number of lessons is located in the Fourth Grade Ancillary Materials folder you downloaded from the CK website.
 Information on this resource can be found on TG pg. 12 and 25.
 - "Take Home Material" listed in the Teacher's Guide refers to activity pages that can be assigned as homework by a classroom teacher. If time is available in your school day, it's a good idea to complete these activity pages whenever possible.
 - The "Who Am I?" journals students create in this unit will be used again in later units so please keep them in a safe place.
 - Advanced preparation is required for all lessons in this unit as well as the assessment and pausing point days.

 Pausing Points: There are two sets of pausing point days, one on each site of the beginning-of-the-year assessment. The potential pausing point activities can be found on pg. 177-188.  instructions. It is possible to use a library copy of this book (although most
 libraries won't own this version), but note the book is needed for a total of 4
 weeks to complete the unit.
- Please note, the lessons in this unit call for reading some (but not all) of the chapters in book. If your student enjoys these stories, consider reading the nonscheduled chapters as time allows, in the evening as a family, etc.
- Advanced preparation is required for all lessons in this unit.
